





Man did eat angels' food: He sent them meat to the full."



"Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim." Exodus 17:8




"Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way,

Israel's Exodus From Egypt



- 1. Rameses Israel was thrust out of Egypt (Exodus 12; Numbers 33:5).
- **2. Succoth** After the Hebrews left this first campsite, the Lord attended them in a cloud by day and in a pillar of fire by night (Exodus 13:20-22).
- **3. Pi-hahiroth** Israel passed through the Red Sea (Exodus 14; Numbers 33:8).
- 4. Marah The Lord healed the waters of Marah (Exodus 15:23-26).
- 5. Elim Israel camped by 12 springs (Exodus 15:27).
- **6. Wilderness of Sin** The Lord sent manna and quail to feed Israel (Exodus 16).
- 7. Rephidim Israel fought with Amalek (Exodus 17:8-16).
- 8. Mount Sinai (Mount Horeb or Jebel Musa) The Lord revealed the Ten Commandments (Exodus 19 & 20).
